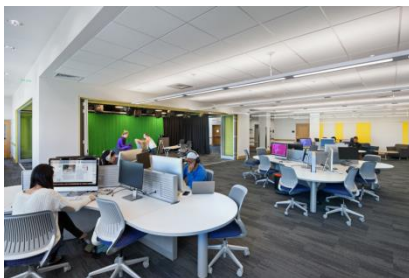

Project Description:

The Jones Media Center supports the instruction and research needs of Dartmouth’s faculty, students, staff and alumni by providing facilities, collections and expertise for researching, viewing and producing a wide range of media.

Facilities include:

- Innovation Studio - a multi-purpose, reconfigurable teaching, learning, and production facility accessible to students and faculty
- Large areas for collaborative multimedia project work
- Casual seating areas
- Semi-private viewing and project rooms
- Standing height workstations
- A technology help desk
- Gaming and visualization labs

In addition, the Center provides equipment and expertise for producing video for classroom and extracurricular projects. User accessible multimedia workstations can interface with smartphones and professional media recording equipment (available on loan) to create advanced multimedia projects. Each workstation also connects to the Innovation Studio, which uses green-screen curtains, an ultrahigh-resolution video wall, and folding glass doors to transform between an instructional area, experimentation lab, and professional video/multi-media studio.
